Venue (www.cloverleyhall.com)

Cloverley Hall is a Christian Conference Centre set in 9 acres of its own grounds in the beautiful Shropshire countryside. Within the grounds, there is a lawn suitable for volleyball, a football pitch, a hard tennis court (which will also be used for pickle ball and football tennis), an indoor heated swimming pool, a games room and a crèche.

Travel (www.cloverleyhall.org/find-us)

- By Air: Both Liverpool and Manchester airports are about 1 hour away by car, with Birmingham about 1¼ hours, East Midlands about 1½ hours, London Luton about 2½ hours and London Heathrow about 3 hours.
- *By Car*: The centre (post code SY13 4PH) is located at Calverhall midway between Whitchurch and Market Drayton on a minor road 6-8 miles from either town. The M6 motorway and Crewe are within twenty miles of Cloverley Hall.
- By Train: The nearest train station to Cloverley Hall is in Whitchurch (Shropshire). A taxi can be pre-booked for the 6-8 miles from Whitchurch to the conference centre.

Accommodation (www.cloverleyhall.org/on-site-at-cloverley-hall/accommodation)

Accommodation in the centre varies. A standard room holds 2-6 people and contains a wash basin. There are 17 en-suite rooms and 4 standard single rooms available at an extra cost. En-suite rooms include a shower and/or bath, toilet and wash basin. Ground floor rooms with handicapped accessibility are limited; if you require such, please notify the booking secretary. All beds have pillows, duvets and all necessary bedding. Please bring your own towels and toiletries.

Coach Trips

1. Blists Hill Victorian Town and Iron Bridge. Step back in time and visit a recreated Victorian village, tasting authentic food and sweets, and joining craftspeople demonstrating their trades (www.ironbridge.org.uk/visit/blists-hill-victorian-town). We will also stop at the historic and impressive Iron Bridge and Toll House at the heart of the area where the Industrial Revolution began (www.en.wikipedia.org/wiki/The_Iron_Bridge). Normal non-group entry to Blists Hill costs £23.50 (adult) and £14 (child), so the BRF price, which includes the coach, is very good value.

Price for you: adult - £25, child (age 5-16) - £15, 4 or under - free.

2. Chester. An authentically-dressed soldier will give us a medieval walking tour of Chester, including England's most complete city walls, the famous 700-year-old "Rows" shops, the largest Roman amphitheatre in Britain, St. John's Cathedral and more (www.chestermedievaltours.com). Chester contains the church in which Bible commentator Matthew Henry (1662-1714) preached and was buried, as well as an obelisk to his memory. You can also check out the Roman shrine to Minerva, the castle, Tudor houses, the military museum, etc. Open top bus tours and boat cruises on the River Dee are available (www.chesterattractions.org.uk).

Price for you: adult - £15, child (age 5-16) - £10, 4 or under - free.
