Dates

The 14th British Reformed Fellowship (BRF) Family Holiday Conference begins on Saturday, 16 July, with arrival at the castle after 4 PM and dinner at 6 PM, and ends with departure from the castle by 10 AM on Saturday, 23 July (DV).

Programme

The conference will be of a relaxed nature and adequate time will be available for fellowship and various on-site activities, as well as 2 day trips. The 6 speeches on “Behold, I Come Quickly:’ The Reformed, Biblical Truth of the End” and the special lecture will be delivered in the evenings and some mornings. The 13th Biennial General Meeting of the BRF will also take place during the conference.

Venue

Built in 1856, Castlewellan Castle stands above an 80-acre lake in approximately 1,300 acres of Forest Park in the northern foothills of the Mourne Mountains in Northern Ireland. These beautiful premises are located some 30 miles south of Belfast and approximately 5 miles from the Irish Sea coast at Newcastle, County Down.

Travel

- *By air*: Castlewellan is about 50 minutes from Belfast City (Harbour) Airport (BHD), 60 minutes from Belfast International Airport (BFS) and 90 minutes from Dublin Airport (DUB). If you are flying within the British Isles or Europe, some discount airlines are available to these airports (www.easyjet.com, www.ryanair.com, www.flybe.com, www.bmibaby.com).
- *By bus*: Buses are available from the airports and elsewhere to Castlewellan via Newcastle and Newry. More information on public transportation can be found on the conference website (<http://brfconference.weebly.com>) or through Translink (www.translink.co.uk).
- *By road*: The town of Castlewellan is located approximately 5 miles from Newcastle. The entrance to the Forest Park and Castle is at the highest part of the town of Castlewellan, opposite the town hall. Once in the park, follow the signs for the “Conference Centre.”

Accommodation

- Bed linen and towels are provided.
- There are just 7 en-suite rooms available—first-come, first-served, so book early. The cost in an en-suite room is higher than in a standard room. Five of the en-suite rooms are on the same floor as the dining hall and meeting room, eliminating the need to climb stairs. Of these five, one is wheelchair accessible.
- Standard rooms vary in size and sleep 2-10 people in twin, double and/or bunk beds. All standard rooms have wash hand basins in the room. Toilets and showers are a short distance from the room on the same floor.
- Due to the nature of the conference centre and because we expect large numbers, single rooms are not available.

Day Trips

- *Day Trip 1*: Boyne Valley - guided tours of (1) the Battle of the Boyne (1690) site, the largest battle ever fought on Irish soil (www.battleoftheboyne.ie), and (2) Trim Castle, the biggest Anglo-Norman castle in Ireland, begun in 1173 (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Trim_Castle).
- *Day Trip 2*: Hillsborough - guided tours of Hillsborough Castle (1770s mansion), the official royal residence in N. Ireland, and its 98 acres of beautiful gardens. The town also has an artillery fort (1650), courthouse (1765), forest, lake walk and restaurants.
- The (reasonable) cost of the day trips will be fixed later. Payment will be made at the conference. Please indicate on the booking form if you intend to go on the trips.

On-Site Activities

- Over 10 miles of nature trails for hiking
- Beautiful gardens and an arboretum just a short stroll from the castle
- One of the world’s largest hedge row mazes
- Castlewellan Town—only a 15-20 minute walk away
- A games room with pool, table tennis, table football and air hockey
- Mountain bikes, kayaks and canoes can be hired on-site (www.onegreatadventure.com) and pony trekking is available nearby (www.mountpleasantcentre.com)

Other Amenities

- The Cellars: a lounge area with free wi-fi and a shop, which opens in the evenings and sells Maud’s ice cream, confectionary and souvenirs
- Laundry facilities are available at the castle, although cheaper in the town of Castlewellan
- If high chairs and cots for infants are needed, please contact the booking secretary
- Camping is available in the forest park (www.nidirect.gov.uk/castlewellan-forest-park-2)
